# Opening NetLibrary


## 3. Click on NetLibrary

# EzProxy Login

- At this point you may be prompted to enter your EzProxy account information. Enter your student ID number (ex. 000xxxxxx) and the first three letters of your first and last name (ex. johndoe).

# Searching NetLibrary

4. In the search box immediately following the box marked “Full-Text,” enter your search term.

5. Click on “search”

# Searching Tips

- If you are looking up a topic, you will receive the best results by only typing in one or two search terms at the outset.
  - Example: Your topic is “Exodus Theology in the Old Testament”
  - Do **NOT** type: Exodus Theology in the Old Testament
  - **Instead** type: Exodus
- If the search gives too many results, try a new search (on the right hand side of the web page) for a narrower term
  - Example: Exodus AND Old Testament
  - Example: Exodus AND Theology
- If the search does not give enough results, try a new search (on the right hand side of the web page) for a different term
  - Example: Old Testament
  - Example: Old Testament AND Theology


10. Then click search.
