### ■ Professional Development:

■ **Experiential Professional Development:** Up to 12 semester hours can be earned from work experience with military performance evaluations, job performance appraisals or a supervisor's evaluation on a WBU form.

■ **General Electives:** Fifteen (15) semester hours are required.
