**Returning Students:** All official transcripts must be received prior to registering for the second term. If it has been over a year since you last attended, you will also need to reapply for admission.

**All Students Financial Accounts:** Prior balances must be paid in full before registration is permitted. Those on financial aid must have their financial aid in order prior to the time of registration. All students may register provided 1/3 payment is made. Payment in full must be made within 60 days from the first day of the term. There are exceptions to the rule for only those students who have third-party billings.

**Notice:** Students are REQUIRED to complete their English requirements (ENGL1301, 1302) within their first year at WBU. Consult an advisor about the order in which you should take other courses.

### ATTENTION CIVILIAN STUDENTS

Access to military installations is granted at the discretion of each base. Therefore, Wayland cannot guarantee your access for classes. If you intend to take classes on Elmendorf or Ft. Richardson, be sure to register early and ask about additional requirements for base access.
