

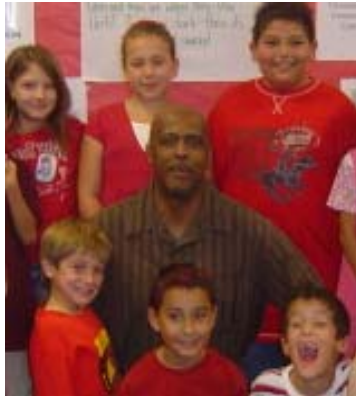

Some people referred to the sound of jets flying overhead as the sound of freedom. If you are not familiar with a military installation you may not have experienced what I call the sound of freedom. As a military dependent station a various military installation there is nothing like the sound of reveille, retreat and taps heard over the base loud speakers to make you feel secure. This sound of freedom can be heard each day at 7:00 am with reveille

“Call to Colors” and at 5:00 pm retreat with the National Anthem and 10 pm Taps. I hope all of you make plans to arrive at 5:00 pm one day to experience the feeling that are military members protect for all of us.

Customs for reveille, retreat and taps.

Civilians

Stand at attention and face the flag the direction of the music. If wearing a cap, remove it. Place the right hand over the heart and hold the position until the last note of music is played.

In a Vehicle

When in a vehicle during reveille and retreat, stop the vehicle at the first sound of the music, pull to the right side of the road and activate the emergency vehicle lights. Stereos should be silenced and all car occupants should sit quietly until the last note of the music is played.

Taps

At the day's end, taps plays at 10 pm During this time, people should remain quiet and respectful until the last bugle note is played. However, it is not necessary to stand at attention and drivers should remain driving.
