### Safety and Security Disclosure

Wayland Baptist University forbids the possession, use, or distribution of alcohol, illicit drugs, and/or drug paraphernalia by students or employees as a part of any activity of the University. Compliance with these standards of conduct for students, faculty, and staff is mandatory.

Firearms for protection or sport are strictly prohibited at Wayland. Absolutely no weapons may be brought by students onto the campus, except by official law enforcement personnel.
