Student Right-to-Know Act
Enrollment and Graduation Rate Reports for Student Athletes

In accordance with the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended, Wayland Baptist University is pleased to share with you the following information on the enrollment of student athletes during Spring 2017 and graduation rates of our 2011 cohort of full-time, first-time, degree seeking undergraduates and varsity student athletes that received athletic financial aid, as well as, four-year average graduation rates of our 2008-2011 first-time full-time cohorts.

While viewing this information, please keep the following in mind:

- All graduation rates are based upon 6 years of attendance which equates to 150% of the normal completion time of our longest program.
- We have elected not to report transfer-out rates because our university's mission does not include providing substantial preparation for students to enroll in another eligible institution without completing or graduating.
- These charts do not identify the reasons why our students withdrew; therefore, students who withdrew for personal or medical reasons are included.
- Graduation rates do not include students who left school to serve in the armed forces or on official church missions or with a foreign aid service of the federal government, or students who died or were totally and permanently disabled.
- A pound sign (#) denotes any cohort/subcohort with five or fewer students. The university is not required to disclose this information.
