This is not a come-and-go event; all students must check in at 8:30. At check-in, we'll check to confirm that you are accepted to Wayland. If we are still missing a final high school transcript showing that you've graduated or a college transcript showing your final grades, you'll need to sign a conditional enrollment form. This just means you agree to get these documents to us and we agree to let you register for classes.</p>

<p>Following the General Session</p>	<p>Pre-Advisory Sessions and Placement Testing – In Various Buildings Across Campus</p> <p>In this step, you'll either go to a pre-advisory session with other students and professors in your area of study <u>or</u> you'll participate in placement testing as required by the Registrar's Office. We'll let you know where you need to go . . . don't worry, you don't have to guess.</p> <p>In both the pre-advisory and testing sessions, you'll learn more about Fall classes and degree plans.</p> <p>If you participate in the testing, you'll receive your scores immediately and they will travel with you to the next step. Your scores will be used to determine the classes in which you may enroll.</p>
<p>Follows Pre-Advisory and Testing</p> <p>Continues Through the Afternoon</p>	<p>Class Registration Begins and Continues Through the Afternoon In the University Center and Gates Hall</p> <p>After your advisory session or placement testing, you'll be directed back to the University Center to continue your registration process.</p> <p>You will make your way to several "stations" according to the sequence on your registration checklist . . .
