- **Gather these supplies:**

- Apron
- Table covering (newspaper, butcher paper, old cloth)
- Pencil
- Canvases or canvas panels (11" by 14" or 16" by 20")
- Brushes in various sizes
- Palette knife or plastic knife (to mix paints)
- 2 containers of water
- Paper towels
- Ruler
- Acrylic paints: yellow, orange, red, violet/purple, blue, white, black and dark brown. (You can use oil or watercolor if you prefer.)
- Palette or paper trays/plates
- Table easel
