\*\* Undergraduate classroom courses for active duty military (per semester hour): \$250/hr. (classroom and online)

Prior balances must be paid in full before registration is permitted. For a two-payment plan (fee of \$25), one half of total tuition is due at the time of registration, and the second half is due 30 days after the first day of the session (**or a \$50 late fee will be incurred**). Students receiving financial aid must have their 2024/2025 award letter prior to the time of registration.
