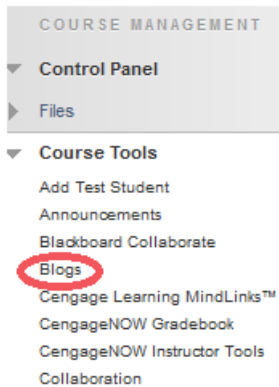


Grading a Blog

After you have created a **Blog** and students have need to grade the **Blog**. You can grade **Blogs** if grading options when you created the **Blog**. If you previously, you can also set-up the grading options properties.

Follow these step-by-step instructions to access and grade **Blogs** in your course:

1. In the Course Management Control Panel, Click on Course Tools and select Blogs.



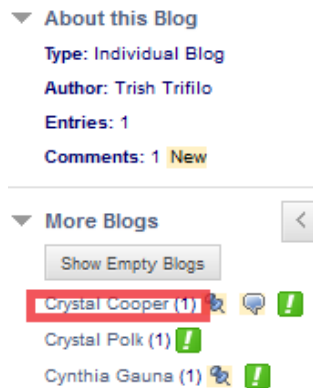
2. Click on the name of the blog you want to grade:



3. A green [!] indicates an entry that requires grading.

Click on the student's name to grade their contribution.


Then click on the "edit grade" box.
