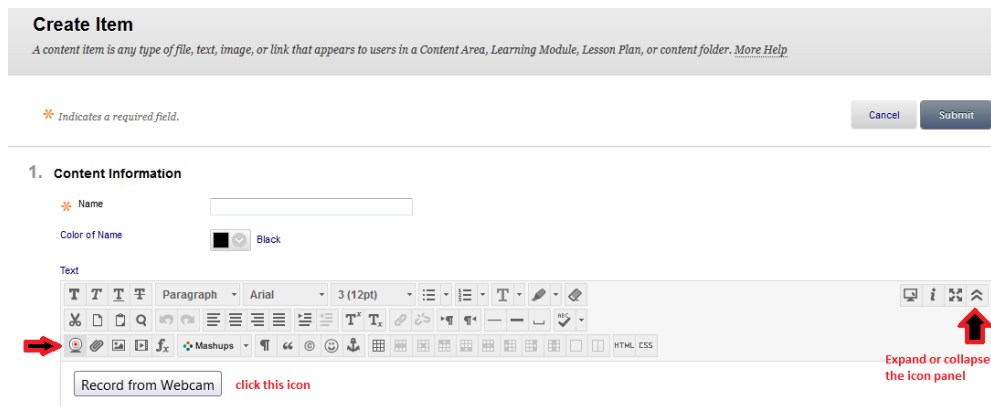
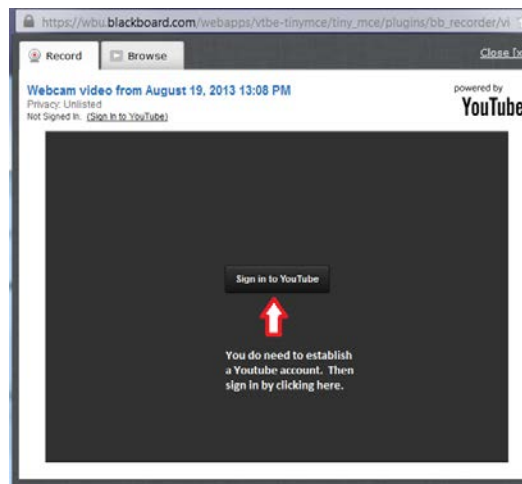


If you want to create short video presentations such as a 3-5 minute lecture where students can see your face and hear your voice, Blackboard has coupled with YouTube to allow easy production. This type of video will not capture your screen or power point slides. It is a great way to welcome your class or clarify a concept you are studying.

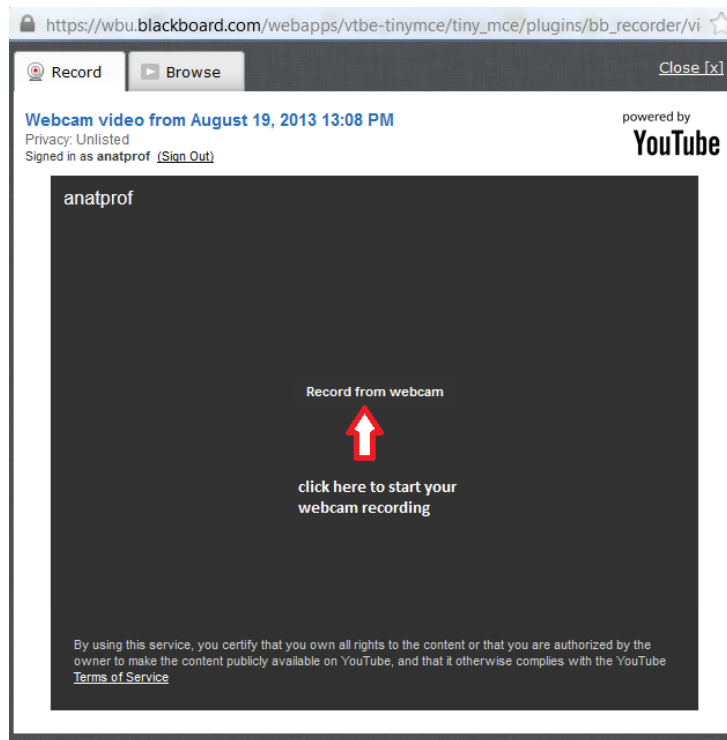
1. Log into Blackboard
2. Go to a course
3. Open a content area where you wish to place the short video
4. Name your video
5. In the textbox area click on the first icon in the third row (remember to expand the icon list if you only see one row).



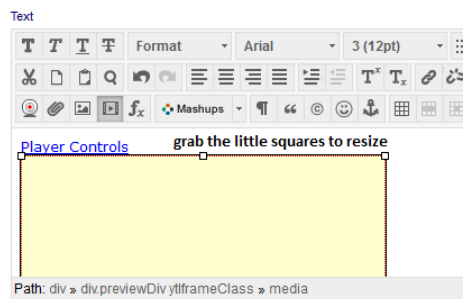
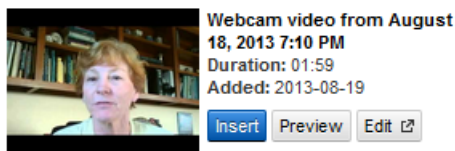
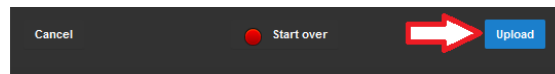
6. Make sure you have a YouTube account set up and login to YouTube and grant Bb permission to access it.



- Click on the record from your webcam button. It will generate a screen where you can see yourself and get situated to record. Then click the record button to start. Click it a second time to stop the recording.



- Click upload to put it into Youtube. You then have the option to preview and do a little editing (this tool is not too refined yet). Then 'Insert". It will appear as a yellow box in the text box.



- Click submit.
